



Driving the New Spring Mountain
Motorsports Ranch 3.1 Mile Road Course

What a blast! CSCC members, Rob Miskowitch, Cliff Wright, and Tim Greenshields recently attended Corvette Days at the new Spring Mountain Motorsports Ranch road-racing course. Along with RMCSC members Steve Yaninek, Bryan Yaninek, Mark Forbes, and Gerry Forbes this group traveled to Pahrump, Nevada (west of Las Vegas 50 miles) and met Denver based drivers, Steve Olson, Alex Nelson, Lee Steele, John Harnagel, Bill Mount, and Alex's business partner Steve.

Many thanks to Alex and Suzanne Nelson at Rocky Mountain Corvette for organizing this fabulous event covering two racing days, February 4, and 5th. An eighteen-wheeler transporter picked up everyone's Corvette in Denver and then delivered the cars to the Las Vegas Bellagio Hotel. After the exciting weekend, cars were returned Denver.

If you haven't been to the new track at the Spring Mountain Motorsports Ranch....go and do it! The venue is a 3.1 road-racing track that is one of the best in the country. It's twice the length of the older track, more challenging, faster, more technical for trail braking and heel and toe braking skills, stunning G-Forces, and gripping speeds that really get your attention. It's better than racing at Texas World, Phoenix International, the late PPIR track in Springs, Hallett in Oklahoma, Heartland in Kansas (site of the SCCA nationals!) and Mid-Ohio.

There are three straights on the new track where drivers can hit 100 mph (the downhill area from the west going east through the esses), 110 mph (the east straight leading to the pit area), and 100 - 125 mph PLUS going west into the new track area. The Colorado drivers thought it was very challenging racing side by side, fender to fender (!) at 115 mph with the other 70 plus drivers from other parts of the country. Drivers were grouped into three categories that included novice, intermediate, and advanced.


Tim Greenshields, one of our SCCA national level drivers, reported that the G-forces of the C5's, C5 Z06's, C6's and especially Bryan Yaninek's double turbo-charged silver bullet C5 Z06 machine were truly amazing! He said that driving Bryan's 750 HP Corvette reminded him of the CAN AM Lolas from the 70's!

Out of the eighty cars entered and the drivers who participated from several parts of the country, our Colorado group was the most enthusiastic, the fastest, and the best! Join us for another one of these events in early November. We might do a caravan to the track following the warmer highways through New Mexico.


