

NCM GROUNDBREAKING & AP EXPANSION

The NCM groundbreaking ceremony for the construction start of the 14,635 sq ft *Holley Control Tower and Events Center* at Motorsports Park was held on May 28, 2015. The facility will provide meeting rooms, administrative offices, a track retail space, a 2,000 sq ft viewing deck, and classrooms. With a \$1.8 million price tag, completion is projected within 8-9 months. Let's hope they investigated the subsurface for sinkholes!

On May 21, GM announced that the Corvette Assembly Plant will build a 450,000 sq ft paint shop, which will be almost half the size of the entire current production facility. The price tag is \$439 million and it will take about 2 years to complete. Did you know that GM does not allow the public to tour or view the paint shops in its assembly plants, and limits access to those employees who actually work in the paint shops. Why? Because contamination of painting operations is a risk, a risk GM doesn't want to take... and besides, the processes are proprietary.
