


We're not talking about the face...as we know who wins that competition!

In 2025 Corvette Offers New Blue Custom Leather Interior Stitching

The [2025 Corvette](#) year marks the sixth model year for the [mid-engine C8](#), bringing with it several important changes. While the hotly anticipated [debut](#) of the new range-topping C8 [Corvette ZR1](#) takes center stage, the custom options list for the 2025 Corvette also offers [a few notable updates](#). Among these is a new **blue custom leather** interior stitching option, as highlighted right here.

The new blue custom leather interior stitching option for the 2025 [Corvette](#) is offered exclusively for the range-topping trims, specifically 3LT for the C8 [Stingray](#), and 3LZ for the C8 [Z06](#), C8 [E-Ray](#), and C8 ZR1. Tagged with [RPO code](#) 37S, pricing is set at \$495.

Additionally, the new blue leather stitching is only available in conjunction with the Jet Black interior colorway and either Napa leather with perforated inserts (RPO code HTE) or Napa leather with perforated sueded microfiber inserts (RPO code HTT). 2. Answer: c; Fightermobile. All the other nicknames listed for the C2 Corvette were used by the press, or GM authorities at one time or another.
3. Answer: d; Bathtub Corvette is a nickname for the C1 Corvettes (1953-1962) due to their rounded, curvy bodywork. The smooth, flowing lines made it look like an elegant yet sporty bathtub on wheels. The lighthearted term underscores the iconic vintage styling of early Corvettes.
4. Answer: a; Garage Queen is a Corvette that is rarely driven and spends most of its time parked in the garage. These Corvettes are often seen as wasted potential because they never hit the road.
5. Answer: c; Flying Doorstop is a humorous nickname for the C4 Corvette due to its sharp wedge-shaped aerodynamic design. This design helped improve high speed stability and aerodynamics.
6. Answer: b; Death Wish Mode is often referred to when a high horsepower Corvette has its traction control completely disabled. Without it the rear tires can easily break loose under acceleration, requiring serious driving skills to handle the Corvette.
7. Answer: d; Snake Eater is a term used by Corvette owners when they beat a Dodge Viper in a race.
8. Answer: c; Sleeper Vette is a Corvette that looks stock but has serious hidden performance modifications such as turbochargers, superchargers, or high horsepower engine builds.
9. Answer: a; The Corvette Wave is a long-standing tradition among Corvette owners. Whether you're driving a classic C1 or a modern C8, a proper Corvette driver always exchange waves.
10. Answer: b; Lawn Chair Gang is a playful term used to describe Corvette owners who park their cars at meets/shows, set up chairs, and just watch the goings-on.
