Non-Z51 & non-Z06 Stingrays are not considered Track Ready due to lack of specific equipment., Damages to basic Stingrays will not be covered by the warranty if incurred during racing.



2026 High Wing ZR1's to Get New Rear Facing Camera

One of the notable features on all C8 Corvette models is the Rear View Mirror, which assists the driver in viewing the surroundings of the car. The Rear View Mirror functions both as a traditional mirror and, with the flick of a switch, transforms into a monitor that displays video from the rear-facing roof-mounted camera. This Rear View Camera offers a larger field of vision for approaching vehicles than the traditional mirror view, effectively reducing blind spots.



When the 2025 Corvette ZR1 was first revealed, many enthusiasts expressed concerns regarding rearward visibility due to the substantial high wing mounted at the rear of the vehicle. Unlike the Z06 High Wing, which has curves, the ZR1's high wing does not, and its considerable size actually obstructs the view from the C8's rear-facing camera situated at the rear of the roof. General Motors has now addressed this issue.

Recently at the Corvette Assembly Plant, a Riptide Blue 2026 Corvette ZR1 being driven by an employee was observed. It was discovered that a second camera has been added to the back-up camera location just above the license plate. The ZR1 with the high wing now features two cameras at this position, while the traditional rear view camera spot on the rear edge of the roof is covered with carbon flash.

Considering that the 2026 Corvette ZR1 incorporates this two-camera system above the license plate, it remains to be seen if all the 2025 ZR1 models will also include this safety feature now that production has commenced.
