


Annual CSCC Christmas Party


University Village Cars & Coffee, January 3, 2026







10. Answer: b; Tony Kleiber. Tony was the Corvette Shop Foreman on June 30, 1953. He drove the first Corvette off the assembly line, as pictured on the cover of this edition of the Vette Set newsletter.
