• Our Concours Success

At the recent National Council of Corvette Clubs (NCCC) convention, our club received a plaque recognizing our 2025 Concours Show as the most attended Corvette Concours event in the nation. This is a tremendous honor and a clear reminder of how successful the Corvette Concours Shows can be when our club comes together.

That success however also comes with a significant amount of work, planning, and leadership.

• Leadership Needed for 2027

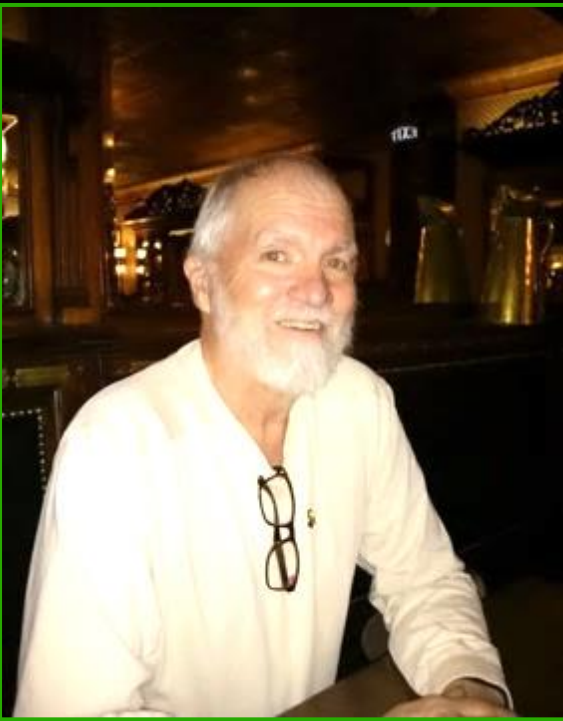

Everyone remembers their first car, and mine will always have a special place in my heart. It was a 1980 Red Chevy Monza with a mighty 4-cylinder engine cranking out about 90 horsepower. By today's standards it wasn't fast, but back in 1985, during my junior year at Rampart High School, I thought it was the coolest car on the road.

I bought it from my Dad, which made it even more special. It wasn't just transportation—it was freedom.

Before I upgraded the sound system, the car still had the original AM radio. That wasn't good enough, so I'd throw a boom box in the back seat and cruise up and down Nevada Avenue with the music turned all the way up. Eventually, I installed a custom stereo system that absolutely rocked... and probably helped contribute to the hearing loss I have today!

Those evenings cruising with friends, windows down, music blasting, and not a care in the world are memories I'll never forget. The Monza wasn't a muscle car, it wasn't rare, and it certainly wasn't powerful—but to a 17-year-old kid, it was everything.

Looking back now, it's funny how our definition of "cool" changes over the years. Today I drive a Corvette, but that little red Monza was the car that sparked my love of driving. It'll always be the one that started it all.

Sometimes the best cars aren't the fastest or the most expensive—they're simply the ones that gave us our first taste of freedom.

1. Answer: a; Yes, the C7 Chevrolet Corvette ZR1 was made in only one year of the C7 generation, 2019. It featured a 6.2L supercharged LT5 V8 producing 755 horsepower and 715 lb-ft of torque. A total of 2,953 were made, 2,441 coupes and 512 convertibles.
2. Answer: a; Yes, the ZR1 C7 was available with either an eight-speed automatic transmission or a 7- speed manual. 2,069 automatic and 884 manual ZR1s of the total 2,953 ZR1s made in 2019.
3. Answer: b; The C7 Corvette was made in the years 2014 – 2019; with a total of 189,507 total during that time. 2017 was the peak production year with 40,689 units made.
4. Answer: a; Yes, the current roster lists 54 C8s and 52 C7s in our club.
5. Answer: b; No, every 7th generation Corvette was built either as a convertible OR as a coupe featuring a removable roof panel (Targa Top).
6. Answer: a; Yes, the Grand Sport Corvette in the C7 was produced only in 2017 thru 2019. It is essentially the “best of both worlds” car, combining the naturally aspirated Stingray engine with the wider aggressive body and track-focused suspension of the Z06.
7. Answer: a; Yes, the Stingray name officially reappeared on a production Corvette with the introduction of the seventh-generation Corvette after a 38-year hiatus as it had not been used by Chevrolet since the 1976 Corvette.
8. Answer: c; Arctic White, Black, and Torch Red dominated the colors for the C7 with Arctic White leading the way with 35,936 units, Black with 31,084 units, and Torch Red with 29,758 of the total 189,507 Corvettes produced.
9. Answer: b; The C7 Corvette was available in 4 main models, the Stingray, Grand Sport, Z06, and ZR1.
10. Answer: d; The defining feature of the C7 Corvette is that it was the final generation of the traditional front-engine, rear wheel drive Corvette layout.
